Objective:

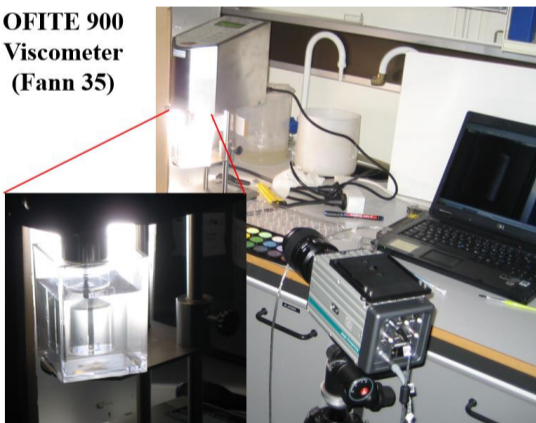

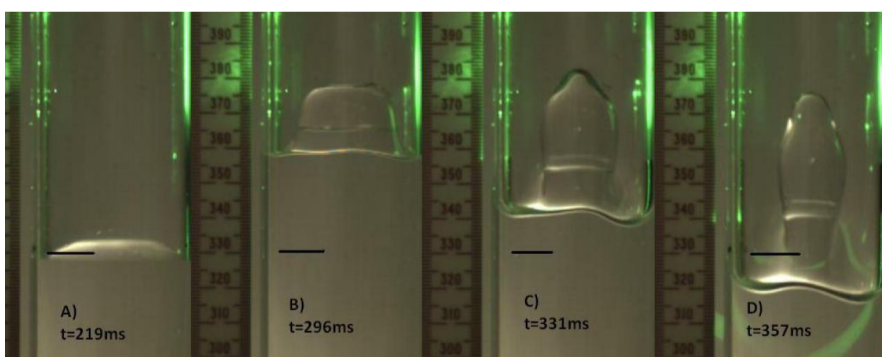
The conference is planned with various plenary speakers, parallel sessions, and poster presentations.

The conference will be held at the University of Stavanger, Kjell Arholms building.

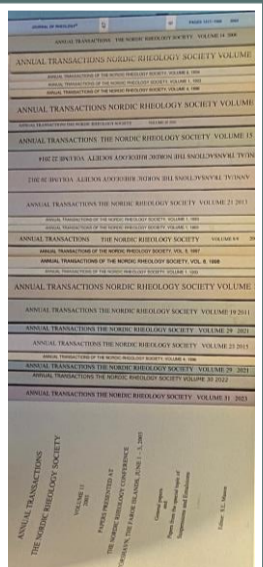
